



The Lost Gospel

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1. History shows that **there are tipping points in time**, where the lack of attention to what is really important causes a loss or a victory. This has something to do with people being intensely committed but they are not paying attention to the right detail or most relevant detail.
2. During the Gettysburg conflict, the hill known as ‘Little Roundtop’ became the tipping point of the American civil war.
3. It was the church that failed to unite spiritually that caused the split between north and south precipitating the American civil war.
4. Lincoln concluded in one of his war-time addresses that the devastation that was happening had something to do with a judgement of God that was not complete yet.
5. The revival in the north never took hold in the south where slavery was seen as an economic benefit, instead of the evil that it perpetrated against the black people.
6. **William Wilberforce, who put an end to the slave trade in Great Britain, created a godly spiritual atmosphere over the nation** which resulted in saving it from the carnage of the French revolution. This happened because of the success of God’s people in protecting the nation’s destiny.
7. **When there is a tipping point, either judgement is going to make the adjustment, or you are!**
8. **Part of the fear of the Lord is that you judge yourself** so that God does not have to do so.
9. So, **if a nation judges itself properly it can avert judgement**. So how do we do this to save our nation of Australia?
10. History is prophetic in its nature! **Firstly, the key ground** is not always the ground everybody’s looking at. **Secondly, if you can find the key ground, the enemy knows it also.**
11. **The real heroes are not necessarily the celebrities but those unknowns who have been prepared for a moment in history.**
12. **It will be the person who is most open to divine strategy** that wins the day and the war.
13. The reviving of the ‘troops’ right now is so necessary because the church does not have enough juice left in the tank to win the battle against culture. This is called transformation fatigue.
14. The church has to some extent developed a theology to explain its failure so they can all feel pretty good about it.
15. **The church is currently operating from a flawed strategy which includes a flawed worldview**. This is changing but it is slow.
16. The tipping point for our country is in places we have not yet looked.
17. **We need to be covert** and take our ‘Little Roundtop’. It may be that our ‘Little Roundtop’ may get gory before the glory is revealed.
18. **We need the Holy Spirit to reveal** where our hill or tipping points are located.
19. **The ‘split gospel’**: The problem we have is what is termed the ‘split gospel’ – which is the ‘spiritual’ verses the ‘secular’.
20. **Believers who are always in the personal, spiritual and next life stuff are not concerned with the natural stuff.**
21. The salvation of souls is seen as more important than the transformation of nations!

22. They fail to observe – or want to get involved with – **the gospel of the Kingdom. This was Jesus' focus. It includes the salvation gospel.**
23. The church is about to have a renaissance of relevance, and the reason it is important is because **you will be bored if you taste revival but do not know how to carry and translate that revival into a lifestyle of the supernatural of where you live.**
24. This means that if you are a believer experiencing a high in the spirit (and keep in your holy huddle) instead of translating what you have into the natural world, you will eventually become bored.
25. Jesus, who lived continually in the presence of the Father, was always engaged in healing the sick, casting out demons, making wine, feeding thousands etc.
26. **God is glorified when He demonstrates His ability to provide for those who are under His dominion. Hence, we should not worry about provision and things like that because the King is the provider in the Kingdom and it's a bad reflection on Him if He does not look after your needs.**
27. The citizens who receive those gifts and provisions are supposed to be the carriers of them to other people. The first level of blessing is God's people, but it is not to end there.
28. **The problem of the church is that it filters scripture through the gospel of salvation lens.**
29. A lot of the Old Testament if read through the gospel of the Kingdom lens (which includes both gospels) will reveal it is referring to principles foundational to the transformation of nations.
30. **We are to go into the nations and teach them how to operate by Kingdom principles – i.e. making disciples of nations.**
31. If we do this, we get to walk in revival outside of the church mountain.
32. You get to heal nations, economies and manifest God's glory.
33. **There is a glory in the mountains that God's wants released.**
34. The church has not understood that: **'He who gets the kingdoms gets the harvest'.**
35. Revelation 5:12 says Jesus is worthy 'to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honour, glory and blessing'.
36. Jesus can release a glory out of the other 6 mountains that will enable the harvest of nations.
37. If we only have glory in the church mountain we will win souls but lose nations. If we are smart we can have both at the same time. We don't have to choose 'either/or'.
38. **You can be a good Christian with power and influence, and you can be spiritually-minded and highly relevant.**
39. The mountains under the Kingdom oversight look like this:
 - the church (*receives honour*),
 - the family (*strength in the family*),
 - education (*wisdom to be manifest*),
 - government (*power to use wisely in balance*),
 - media (*blessing – good news instead of bad*),
 - arts (*glory-distinct from all the other mountains*),
 - business (*riches used for good*).
40. **♦ King:** A 'king' is a person of extraordinary influence or affluence. They are **the opinion-shapers and decision-makers** of nations.
41. **♦ Actualization:** This is when you are 100% alive doing what you were called and destined to do, entirely using all of your gifts for a cause that has great meaning.

42. It is important to be actualized.
43. If you do not actualize, you will **not unveil your glory** to others, and you will rob God of glory.
44. Actualized believers are **the ones who go to the top** of the peaks.
45. “Christ in you, the hope of glory”, is the person sitting next to you.
46. **Glory is the full manifestation of what God designed you to do.**
47. **How do you reveal your glory, the glory that excels?**
 - **It is when you manifest the excellent spirit** (the design God gave you),
 - **that when you fully express it and manifest it;**
 - **it displaces darkness;**
 - **it shows superior results;** &
 - **it attracts attention to you that can then divert through you to Him.**
48. We need to know our assignment in this next season of revival, because once you get lit, the only way you stay lit is to be in the assignment that God lit you for.
49. **If all you are going to do is just to burn in the presence of God, you are going to become irrelevant.** But if you want to experience “glory to glory”, you have to be walking with Him where He moves because He said, “Where I am, my servant shall be also”.

Summary.

- We need to understand how tipping points work and look out for them because it can result in a victory instead of a loss.
- Tipping points often have ‘Little Roundtops’ which dramatically affect the outcome.
- We need to translate what we receive in the spirit and make supernatural changes in the natural.
- We are to disciple the nations by teaching Kingdom principles in a covert manner.
- We need to be fully actualized.

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
